

With reference and reception of the guidelines and recommendations of the Lazio Region and the Ministry of Health concerning the **Coronavirus-related health emergency (SARS-CoV-2) and related disease (COVID19)**, the Nuova Itor Hospital has put in place protocols, procedures and paths aimed at limiting the circulation of the virus and the risk of infection. These activities will have an effect, temporary and until the end of the COVID19 emergency, on the standard methods of providing our services.

In summary, we illustrate you a series of operating methods and restrictions in force within the structure as communicated directly by the health team at the time of taking care of the patient and/or the telephone triage both through specific notices and infographics and also available on the website at the following address: www.clinicanuovaitor.it

1. At the entrance to the structure, to all staff and to all patients, caregivers, any visitors and suppliers will be measured body temperature through Thermoscanner:
 - In the case of detection of a body temperature above 37,3 °C, verified on two measurements, entry into the structure will not be allowed;
 - If body temperature is > 37.5 °C oxygen saturation is measured by the on-call doctor for subsequent medical evaluation.
 - For all visitors, including suppliers, and outpatient patients, in case of passing the body temperature control, there is still a need to fill out a specific Questionnaire aimed at identifying any risky contacts or epidemiological situations to be evaluated, as well as on the presence of any signs and clinical symptoms related to COVID-19.
2. The patient, relative /caregiver, and any suppliers at the entrance to the structure must carry out hand hygiene with hydroalcolic solution (*dispensers* available at the entrance) and wear at the entrance a mask, preferably surgical, with supervision of the health care professional who will verify the correct mode of application. The mask must be maintained for the entire period of stay in the clinic;
3. Access to the Wards by *relatives and caregivers* is limited as per current legislation and by specific indications and operating methods provided by the Responsible Doctor or Coordinator at the time of taking care of the patient.

Please comply with the recommendations and indications for limiting coronavirus (SARS-CoV-2) infection both within the structure and at home, with particular reference to physical distancing and use of the mask, frequent hand hygiene, the "respiratory toilet" and the prohibition of crowds.
